

#### A note from our principal Ms. Nelson:

I am proud to announce that we had a successful opening of school here at Rocky River High School. Our students are great and have acclimated well to our school! This year we have introduced several new initiatives related to our four key priorities this year. Our four key priorities include:

- Increasing student academic success using data,
- Providing strong feedback to teachers to improve their performance,
- Increasing our positive and safe school culture, and
- Celebrating our staff.

Over the course of September, we have been focused on increasing our positive and safe school culture. This month, our students have learned more about the Rocky River High School Code. Below is a brief explanation of the code:

- Respect Taking yourself, others, your education and our school property seriously.
- Responsibility Taking ownership and doing what is right.
- Honor Exhibiting strong moral character, even when no one is looking.
- Service Positively contribute to our RRHS community.

October brings cold and flu season. Here are some suggestions for preventing the spread of flus and viruses:

- Wash hands frequently with soap and water, especially before eating.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Cough or sneeze into a sleeve or elbow, not hands.
- Disinfect frequently touched surfaces.
- Keep your child home when he or she is fevered or feeling sick. Establish a contingency plan for keeping a sick child at home or picking him or her up from school so you are prepared if illness strikes.
- Keep your child at home for at least 24 hours after he or she is free of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications.
- Talk with your healthcare provider about annual seasonal flu vaccines.
