

A note from our principal Ms. Nelson:

September 8, 2015

Dear Rocky River High School Families,

I am proud to announce that we had a successful opening of school here at Rocky River High School. Our students are great and have acclimated well to our school! This year we are continuing our initiatives from last year, grounded around four key priorities. Our four key priorities include:

- Increasing student academic success using data more effectively,
- Increasing the amount of student engagement in ALL of our classrooms,
- Increasing our positive and safe school culture, and
- Celebrating our staff.

Positive School Culture: Over the course of September, we have been focused on increasing our positive and safe school culture. This month, our students have learned more about the Rocky River High School Code. Below is a brief explanation of the code:

- Respect Taking yourself, others, your education and our school property seriously.
- Responsibility Taking ownership and doing what is right.
- Honor Exhibiting strong moral character, even when no one is looking.
- Service Positively contribute to our RRHS community.

Any student that exhibits these characteristics is entered into a drawing for a prize at the end of each week. Every Friday, we draw three names and they win a prize. Our students love this activity and we have seen a great difference in the positive interactions with them. We always could use cool prizes for our students (gift cards, electronics, etc). Every little bit helps! Please bring donated prizes to the main office and speak to Ms. Crawford.

School Report Card: Additionally, throughout the year, we provide regular updates to you about your child's academic progress by conducting parent/teacher conferences and sending home a Report Card. Once a year, we provide you with updates on our school's achievements through the North Carolina School Report Card. This Report Card includes important information about school and student performance, class sizes, attendance, school safety, instructional resources, and teacher quality. There also is information about how our school measured against federal Annual Measurable Objectives (AMO) targets and the number of suspensions and expulsions in our school.

A note from our principal Ms. Nelson continued...

This year, for the second time, report cards also will include an A through F School Performance Grade. <u>The state's School Performance Grade for Rocky River High School is C. Last year, our School Performance Grade was a C.</u>

The grades are calculated and reported by the NC Department of Public Instruction and required based on legislation passed by the North Carolina General Assembly last year. They are based 80 percent on proficiency (the percentage of students in the school at or above grade level in a specific subject) and 20 percent on growth (the rate at which students in the school learned over the past year).

The numbers on the Report Card only tell part of the story. At Rocky River High School, we are proud of the following special activities that are underway to support your child's academic success:

- Engaging in teacher professional development regarding how we use our academic data to address student misunderstandings.
- Incorporating more opportunities for students to show our school's positive character traits of Respect, Responsibility, Honor, and Service (RRHS).
- Celebrating our student leaders for their accomplishments in art, music, academics, community service and athletics through various programs.
- Seeking partnerships with over 5 community organizations to support our students academically and through various mentorships.

We have set strong academic goals for the end of this year and are working diligently to meet those goals. Your involvement is very important to the success of our school. I encourage you to review our Report Card carefully. Well-informed parents who participate in their children's education and school enhance the learning environment for students and educators alike.

Also, our students will receive progress reports this month. Please feel free to reach out to our Attendance Secretary, Ms. Hilliard (carrianne.hilliard@cms.k12.nc.us) for more information about how to access your child's grades on PowerSchool.

As we continue the accomplishments we have garnered this past year, my pledge to you is that we will also continue to create a culture of excellence, leadership, and pride throughout our school community. I look forward to seeing you sometime soon.
